This includes lump sum, construction management, and design build with the ability to lead a team in the preparation of estimates for major projects (up to \$100,000,000+). This position will be in our Winnipeg, MB office.

## **CORE RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES:**

- **Team Management**: Lead, mentor, and develop a team of estimators, ensuring they have the necessary tools, training, and resources to succeed.
- Project Estimation: Lead, oversee and assist in the preparation of detailed quantity calculations
  and cost estimates for projects, including labor, materials, equipment, subcontractor and time
  (general conditions) requirements.
- **Bid Management:** Coordinate the bid process, ensuring all estimates are prepared, reviewed, and submitted on time and in accordance with client requirements.
- **Strategy**: Analyze strategies, advantages, or innovations for the projects that will help Sigfusson Northern win bids.
- **Cost Analysis:** Analyze historical data, market trends, and pricing to improve the accuracy of estimates and competitiveness of bids.
- **Collaboration:** Work closely with project managers, engineers, architects, and clients to ensure all relevant information is considered during the estimation process.
- **Risk Assessment:** Identify potential risks in project bids and work with relevant departments to mitigate these risks.



- **Process Improvement:** Continuously evaluate and improve estimation processes, tools, and methodologies to enhance efficiency and accuracy.
